Class: Beginning Serger

Instructor: Mary Sue Christenbury

Fee: \$95.00 (includes 4 sessions)

Description: Dust off your serger and come learn how to thread and use your 4 thread overlock and 3 thread rolled hem. Serger must be in good working order. You will learn how to properly thread your serger, how to rethread it, adjust your tension\*, and cutting blade position. We will correctly thread and discuss the purpose of each thread. We will make a Cosmetic B, Roll Hem napkin edges, and pillow case.

Projects: Cosmetic Bag, Napkins, Pillow Case

*\*This class is designed for people who own sergers that have tension dials. However, if you do not have tension dials on your machine, you may still take this class.*

Pattern: Included with class

Supplies:

- Owner's Manual for your Serger
- One 16" Zipper
- Serger thread for your 3 or 4 thread serger (one cone that matches your fabric and three other colors)
- Straight Pins
- Sewing Shears for cutting
- Seam ripper – just in case you make a mistake
- 6" gauge or other small ruler
- Serger
- We will be using a straight stitch machine also (you may use our classroom machine if you do not want to bring yours)

Matching thread for your straight stitch machine

Fabric Requirements: (please cut fabric pieces before class & have fusible fabric fused)

For Cosmetic Bag:

- One piece of fabric 14" x 21" = outside of the bag
- One piece of fabric 14" x 21" = inside lining of bag
- One scrap piece of 3" x 3" scrap fabric for hanging loop
- One piece of 14" x 21" fusible vinyl (fused to right side of lining fabric)
- One piece of 14" x 21" fusible fleece (fused to wrong side of outside fabric)

For Two Napkins:

- ½ yard (for 18" napkins) of 45" fabric (Cut into 2 equal squares)

For Pillow Case: (if fabric was torn, square up edges before class)

- Body of pillow case: ¾ yard
- Pillowcase band: ¼ yard
- Contrasting band: 1/8 yard

Class Policy:

-The class fee must be collected when you sign up for the class to guarantee your seat. Each fee is listed next to the class listing.

-If you cannot attend a class for which you have registered you must let us know 7 days prior to class time. We will be happy to refund your class fee and/or register you in another class.

-If you cancel after the 7-day time allowance, up until the day of the class, your class fee is nonrefundable.

-A minimum of 3 students is required for class. If this requirement is not met, usually the class will be canceled and you will be refunded your class fee.
